Program Overview

The Master of Music programme at Yarmouk University started in 2005. The minimum duration of the Master's programme is two years. The programme has two tracks (Comprehensive, Thesis)

Program Objectives

To train a generation of scientists and researchers in the field of music, and to provide scientific competence in the field of music to meet the needs of the local market in various areas, creating qualitative scientific experiments, keeping pace with the wheel of technological change.

Program Importance

-The programme opens the doors of academic cooperation with Arab and international universities in the fields of scientific research, joint supervision and discussion of scientific theses, and specialised academic meetings in various fields of music, such as lectures, seminars, workshops and others.

-The programme provides advanced teaching materials for faculty members of different academic ranks and stimulates the academic atmosphere for them, which requires the preparation and follow-up of all new developments in the various musical sciences.

-The programme enriches the local and Arab arena with new research topics in the form of the preparation of dissertations and scientific researches that have not yet been presented, which will contribute to addressing various scientific issues in the fields of music; including Field studies, development of school and university curricula, preservation of Arab and international musical heritage, and development of various musical performance methods.

Targeted Groups and Accepted Majors

Holders of a Bachelor's degree in a music-related subject; other subjects closely related to music or other disciplines may be considered, provided the student passes a music aptitude test.

Job Areas

The Jordan Radio and Television Corporation and its Music Department, the Armed Forces, the Ministry of Information, the Ministry of Culture, the Ministry of Education, private schools, public and private universities that teach music, and job opportunities outside of Jordan.

Credit Hours and Tuition Fees

33 study hours.

Hourly rate is 70 JOD for Jordanian students, and 225 USD for international students.

Study Plan Overview

The master's degree in music is awarded after a minimum of 24 credit hours at the (600) level have been studied and passed with a cumulative average of at least 75%, with remedial courses as determined by the department's graduate studies committee Dissertation Track: 24 hours (15 compulsory + 9 elective + 9 Master's thesis) Comprehensive Track: (24 compulsory hours + 9 elective hours)
