A. Admission Requirements:

Students wishing to enroll in this program must satisfy the following two conditions:

- Have a bachelor degree in english.
- Have a Master's degree in English language curricula and instruction. Applicants with a Masters' degree in linguistics, English Language and Literature or Translation can be considered for admission provided that they study remedial and/or additional courses as required by the Department
- Meeting the English language requirements as outlined by the decisions of the Higher Education Council.

B. Degree Requirements:

- 1. Meeting the conditions stipulated in the Doctoral program regulations number (4) for the year 2011.
- 2. Completion of remedial courses recommended by the department graduate studies committee.
- 3. Studying and successfully passing at least (36) credit hours from the level of (700) and above.
