#### Ph.D Degree in Social Studies Curricula and Instruction

##### A. Admission Requirements:

Students wishing to enroll in this program must satisfy the following two conditions:

- Have a bachelor degree in the major of Geography , History , sociology and social studies / field teacher .
- Have a Master's degree in the major of Geography History , sociology and social / Field teacher . Other majors of general educational curricula might be granted a conditional admission upon the master's thesis being in the specialization
- Meeting the English language requirements as outlined by the decisions of the Higher Education Council.

##### B. Degree Requirements:

1. Meeting the conditions stipulated in the Doctoral program regulations number (4) for the year 2011.
2. Completion of remedial courses recommended by the department graduate studies committee.
3. Studying and successfully passing at least (36) credit hours from the level of (700) and above.
