A. Admission Requirements:

Students wishing to enroll in this program must satisfy the following two conditions:

- Have a bachelor degree.
- Have a Master's degree in one of the following disciplines: (Islamic Economics and Banking, Islamic Economics, Economics, finance and baking, Islamic banks, fiqh).
- Meeting the English language requirements as outlined by the decisions of the Higher Education Council.

B. Degree Requirements:

1. Meeting the conditions stipulated in the Doctoral program regulations number (4) for the year 2011.
2. Completion of remedial courses recommended by the department graduate studies committee.
3. Passing the memorization (of Surat Al-Baqarah) before the formation of a committee debate.
